Visiting the Masai Mara in November

TIN NOVEMBER, THE MASAI MARA TRANSFORMS INTO A LUSH GREEN PARADISE. THE SHORT RAINS SWEEP ACROSS THE SAVANNAH, TURNING THE GOLDEN PLAINS INTO A CARPET OF EMERALD GRASS, DOTTED WITH WILDFLOWERS SUCH AS FIREBALL LILIES AND FLAME LILIES. DRAMATIC AFTERNOON THUNDERSTORMS ROLL IN, BRINGING LIFE TO THE MUSIARA MARSH AND REFRESHING THE WOODLANDS. FOR ARTISTS, PHOTOGRAPHERS, AND NATURE LOVERS, THIS IS ONE OF THE MOST INSPIRING TIMES TO VISIT — THE MARA FEELS VIBRANT, RENEWED, AND ALIVE.

WHAT WILDLIFE CAN I SEE?

THIS IS A SEASON OF ABUNDANCE AND NEW BEGINNINGS. ELEPHANT FAMILIES GATHER IN IMPRESSIVE HERDS, FEEDING ON FRUITING WARBURGIA TREES AND OFTEN ROAMING CLOSE TO THE GOVERNORS' CAMPS. BUFFALO, GIRAFFE, AND WARTHOGS ARE SEEN THROUGHOUT THE PLAINS, WHILE NEWBORNS APPEAR EVERYWHERE — TOPI CALVES, IMPALA FAWNS, AND YOUNG GIRAFFES TAKING THEIR FIRST STEPS. JACKALS AND BAT-EARED FOXES ARE BUSY WITH THEIR OWN PUPS, WHILE HYENAS TEND TO THEIR DENS WITH VERY YOUNG CUBS.

THE WILDEBEEST MIGRATION LINGERS AS THE GREAT HERDS GRAZE DOWN THE LAST OF THE GRASSES, PREPARING TO TREK SOUTH. LATE RIVER CROSSINGS CREATE BREATHTAKING SCENES OF WILDEBEEST AND ZEBRA BRAVING THE MARA RIVER. LIONS, PARTICULARLY THE MARSH AND PARADISE PRIDES, TAKE FULL ADVANTAGE, WHILE RESIDENT MALES PATROL THEIR RANGES WITH RENEWED ENERGY. CHEETAHS THRIVE ON THE SHORT GRASS PLAINS, SOME WITH TINY CUBS HIDDEN IN THICKETS, WHILE LEOPARDS LURK ALONG THE RIVERINE WOODLANDS.

BIRDS

NOVEMBER IS ALSO A SPECTACULAR MONTH FOR BIRDWATCHERS. MIGRANTS ARRIVE IN NUMBERS, FROM PALLID AND MONTAGU'S HARRIERS SWEEPING THE SKIES TO YELLOW WAGTAILS AND RED-THROATED PIPITS GATHERING ON THE PLAINS. ALONG THE MARA RIVER AND MARSHES, SANDPIPERS AND STORKS FEED, WHILE BEE-EATERS, ROLLERS, AND SHRIKES BRING FLASHES OF COLOR. BABOONS AND BLUE MONKEYS ARE DRAWN TO FRUITING TREES, FILLING THE FORESTS WITH MOVEMENT AND SOUND.

A RARE MOMENT IN TIME

NOVEMBER IN THE MASAI MARA IS A MONTH OF CONTRASTS: HOT, BRIGHT MORNINGS, LUSH GREEN PLAINS ALIVE WITH NEWBORNS, AND DRAMATIC EVENINGS FILLED WITH THUNDER, RAIN, AND BIRDSONG. IT IS A TIME WHEN ELEPHANTS ROAM IN GREAT HERDS, LIONS AND CHEETAHS FIND PLENTIFUL PREY, AND THE AIR HUMS WITH NEW LIFE. FOR TRAVELERS AND ARTISTS, IT OFFERS AN UNPARALLELED OPPORTUNITY TO WITNESS THE MARA AT ITS MOST VIBRANT — A LIVING CANVAS OF COLOR, ENERGY, AND ABUNDANCE.

Governors' Il Moran Camp

Governors' Il Moran Camp is small and intimate, with added touches that place this camp at the top of the safari accommodation range. This is the camp for those who want that extra bit of luxury.

Hidden under ancient trees deep in the forest, are just ten tents which line the winding banks of the Mara River. Hippos wallow in the river waters below, elephants wander through camp and the night time is punctuated by hyena whoops and lion calls.

Each tent enjoys a private location from which to enjoy the beautiful and serene setting. The rooms are expansive and furnished to a superior standard. Beautiful recycled old wood furniture and muted natural tones are a natural extension of the environment around. Each stylish bathroom boasts a Victorian style bath, while a large verandah at the front is designed for relaxing in comfort within the peaceful surroundings.

Meals are served on the raised wooden decking of the main mess and dining tent which offers a bird's eye view of the snorting hippos below. The main feature is a sunken fire pit which is lit with hot coals in the evenings - the perfect spot to sit back with a cocktail of your choice. Tales shared around the campfire are not uncommon, but neither is escap- ing into your own intimate and romantic safari getaway.

This camp has been awarded a GOLD Eco Rating by Eco-Tourism Kenya for our sustainable tourism practices in place.

THE MASAI PEOPLE

No journey to the Masai Mara is complete without meeting the people who have called this land home for centuries — the Maasai. Known worldwide for their vibrant red shúkàs (robes), intricate beadwork, and tall, elegant stature, the Maasai are a proud semi-nomadic people whose traditions remain deeply connected to the rhythms of the land and wildlife around them.

Cattle lie at the heart of Maasai culture, symbolizing wealth, sustenance, and community. Villages, known as enkangs, are still arranged in traditional circles of mudand-thatch homes, with livestock at the center. Daily life is rich with song, dance, storytelling, and ceremonies that mark each stage of life. Women craft exquisite bead jewelry that reflects both beauty and social meaning, while men are guardians of the herds and warriors of the savannah.

Since the beginning of the 20th Century the cheetah population has fallen dramatically from 100'000 individuals to 7'500 individuals with human activity a major cause. It is therefore important to understand the cheetah-human interface, which is one of the key works of the Mara-Meru Cheetah Project, led by Dr. Elena Chelyseva. Our Governors' Guides play a critical role in the data collection for Dr. Elena and her team, reporting through sightings and behaviour observations of cheetah spotted. Dr Elena enjoys sharing her expertise on the cheetahs in the area with our guests through talks or by accompanying guests game drives.


Hot Air Balloon Safari Included

For those looking for an adventure of a different kind, we suggest a magical hot air balloon safari over the Masai Mara. The adventure begins just before dawn. Departure is from a launch site just 15 minutes drive away. Guests assemble at the launch site for a briefing as the flames from the hot air balloon burners light the darkness as the crews inflate their craft. As the dawn breaks, the hot air balloon fills and then rises. Suspended in a basket beneath the rainbow-coloured canopy, you're off for a wildlife viewing adventure with an entirely different perspective. What amazes most first-time balloonists is the absolute stillness — the silence as you float above the plains, the forest and the rivers of the Masai Mara. After about an hour or so, your balloon safari finishes with a flourish. In the time-honoured tradition of balloon flights the world over, toast your return to earth with sparkling wine and enjoy a delicious breakfast that is set up and served at a very special spot. The experience ends with a game drive back to your camp.









Sheldrick Elephant Sanctuary - Nairobi

A highlight of your time in Nairobi will be a visit to the Sheldrick Wildlife Trust, the world-renowned sanctuary dedicated to rescuing and rehabilitating orphaned elephants. Founded in 1977 by Dr. Dame Daphne Sheldrick in memory of her husband, the pioneering naturalist David Sheldrick, the trust has become a global leader in wildlife conservation.

At the sanctuary, you'll witness the incredible bond between the keepers and the young elephants in their care. Many of these calves were orphaned through poaching or human-wildlife conflict, yet here they are given a second chance. Guests can observe their daily routines — playful mud baths, bottle feedings, and social interactions that reveal the elephants' remarkable intelligence and resilience.

Beyond the joy of seeing these gentle giants up close, the Sheldrick Trust offers a profound reminder of the importance of conservation. Every elephant that graduates from the nursery is carefully reintegrated back into the wild, joining protected herds in Tsavo National Park.

For our group, this visit is more than sightseeing — it is an inspirational encounter with the very heart of Kenya's conservation story. The sanctuary embodies hope, healing, and the enduring relationship between humans and elephants, leaving every visitor deeply moved.

HERE, YOU CAN MEET THE ARTISANS, LEARN ABOUT THEIR CRAFT, AND PURCHASE STUNNING SOUVENIRS THAT DIRECTLY SUPPORT LOCAL WOMEN'S LIVELIHOODS.

KAREN BLIXEN MUSEUM - STEP INTO "OUT OF AFRICA"
